



NOTICE OF ELECTION

CITY OF DOVER

GENERAL EMPLOYEE

PENSION BOARD

In accordance with Chapter 80, Article IV, Division 3, Sections 80-521 and 80-522 of the Dover Code, a Pension Board Election will be held to fill the vacancy established by the adoption of the City of Dover Ordinance #2024-07, which introduced a fourth participant to the board, the term which expires June 30, 2027.

Any active, retired, or vested member of the General Employee Pension Plan (excluding spouses) is eligible to vote.

Any qualified voter may cast their vote by **ABSENTEE BALLOT** if they are unable to appear at the polling place on the dates and times of the election for any of the following reasons:

- In the public service of the U.S. or of this State, or a citizen of the U.S. temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the U.S. and the District of Columbia, or such person's spouse or dependent when residing with or accompanying the person, or absent from this State because of illness or injury received while serving in the armed forces of the U.S.; or
- In the armed forces of the U.S. or the Merchant Marines of the U.S., or attached to and serving with the armed forces of the U.S. in the American Red Cross or United Service Organizations; or
- Because of the nature of such person's business or occupation (This includes students and those providing care to a parent, spouse or that person's child who is living at home and requires constant care due to illness or injury); or
- Sick or physically disabled; or
- Absent from the municipality while on vacation; or
- Unable to vote at a certain time or on a certain day due to the tenets or teachings of that person's religion; or
- Residency outside of the Dover area which makes it infeasible to vote in person.

All requests for an absentee ballot must be received by the City Clerk's Office by 12:00 noon on Wednesday, February 12, 2025. Qualified voters may also absentee vote in the City Clerk's Office at 15 Loockerman Plaza, Dover, Delaware.
