Camp Small Wonder

FOR AGES 3 to 12

Hosted by the City of Dover's Youth Connections & Delaware State University this camp is held at the Lab School on the Delaware State University campus. The camp offers children seven weeks of a wide range of activities including arts & crafts, table games, sports, playground, swimming pool, tennis, nature hikes and hours of fun. The participants will take special trips to Killen's Pond, Rehoboth Beach, Hershey Park and Bush Gardens (*schedule is subject to change*).

Limited space is available and registrations are accepted on a first come first serve basis until all slots are filled, so early registration is strongly encouraged. Acceptance letters will not be sent out. Once your payment and registration is accepted, your child/en will be automatically enrolled in the camp. We do not accept Purchase of Care from the State of Delaware.

Children must bring their own lunch, drinks and snacks each day. The lunch must be packed in a cooler or thermos insulated bag.

Form of payment is limited to cash / checks / money orders, sorry credit cards are not accepted for the Camp Small Wonder camp.

Candidates must complete an application and return it to the City of Dover Parks & Recreation office, in Schutte Park, by Tuesday, June 7. Three (3) letters of recommendation, with two needing to be from a school teacher or administrator, are required with application. Selected applicants will go through an interview process and those selected will then need to pay the activity fee.
